We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results of **M/s. Golden Carpets Limited** for the period ended **30th June 2017** this statement attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing obligations and disclosure requirements) Regulations, 2015. The statement is the responsibility of the Company's Management and has been approved by the Board of Directors in their meeting held on 10th August, 2017. Our responsibility is to issue a report on these financial statements based on our review.

We conducted our review in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagement (SRE) 2400, 'Review of Interim Financial Information performed by the independent Auditor of the Entity', issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the financial statement is free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provide less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

The unaudited financial results for the quarter ended 30th June 2017 included in the statement, based on the previously issued results of the Company prepared in accordance with the Accounting Standards as per Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 7 of the Companies(Accounts) Rules,2014 ("Previous GAAP"). Those unaudited financial results prepared under previous GAAP were reviewed by the predecessor auditors, whose limited review report dated 12th August 2016 expressed unmodified conclusion on those unaudited financial results. Management has adjusted those unaudited financial results for the differences in the accounting principles adopted by the company on transition to Indian Accounting Standards ('IND AS') and presented reconciliation for the same, which has been approved by the Company's Board of Directors but have not been subjected to review.

Based on our review conducted as above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying statement prepared in accordance with the accounting standards as per Section 133 of the companies Act, 2013 and other recognized accounting practices and policies has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and SEBI circular dated 05 July 2016 including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
